#### THE SEPTEMBER GATHERING



Timone is well-versed in Scripture and will have some very interesting and insightful things to say.

**Fr. Timone will be offering Mass for us in the Retreat Center Chapel on Sunday afternoon**, so bring your Sunday Missals. We will start our meeting with Mass, after which we will adjourn to the Clare Room for Father's talk on The Beatitudes. Our speaker has served many years as a priest and educator in New York's Hudson Valley. Besides his position as a faculty member in the religious studies department at Mount St. Mary College, Newburgh, he also served on the faculty at Our Lady of Lourdes High School, Poughkeepsie. He was director of the Pope John Paul I Seminary Residence in Hyde Park and served as Dutchess County director of the Office of Christian and Family Development. This year marks Fr. Timone's 50<sup>th</sup> year as a priest – a Golden Jubilee!

# Saints of the Month -

#### St. Elzear & Blessed Delphina

Elzear and Delphina are the only Franciscan couple to be elevated to the status of saint and blessed by the Church.

Elzear was born in 1286 to a noble family in southern France. Delphina was born in 1283. Though married, they made a vow of perpetual virginity. They joined the Secular Franciscans and dedicated themselves to works of mercy.

They invited twelve poor people to dine with them every day. Every member of the household was expected to attend Mass daily, go to confession weekly and to forgive injuries. Like Francis, Elzear and Delphina came to see that all creation points to its source and gives thanks to God. Although childless, their marriage was life-giving for the many poor and sick people they helped. Their joint feast day is September 26<sup>th</sup>.
