Rosemary O'Hagen

Rosemary O'Hagan was born on May 2, 1932 and died on November 9, 2000 at the age of 68. Rosemary last resided in San Marcos, San Diego County, California. Rosemary is buried at Mission San Luis Rey Cemetery in Oceanside California. Mary's cemetery marker, shared with her husband, Joseph, bears the Franciscan Coat of Arms, reflecting her profession as a Secular Franciscan and indicates her deep and abiding faith, 'My Lord and My God.'





The <u>Franciscan Coat of Arms</u> is a deeply meaningful Franciscan symbol. In the background of the image is the <u>Tau Cross</u>. St. Francis used the Tau in his writings, painted it on the walls of the places where he stayed, and even used it as his signature. In front are two crossed arms: Christ's right hand with the nail wound from his cross and Francis' left hand bearing the stigmata. The image is one of *love*: both God's overflowing love poured out for us and in St. Francis with the stigmata, a demonstration of a Francis' absolutely wholehearted and enthusiastic *response* to God's love.
